- What is your definition of a successful business?
- How will your business survive in challenging times, such as the current economic and health crisis? What innovations will you implement so you can pivot during a crisis?
- What do you look for in an employee and how will you retain good employee(s)? How many employees do you project in 2 years and thereafter?
